

NONPROFIT PARTNER SEARCH - KEYWORD LIST

This keyword document will help you to think more broadly about partner organizations. There are many organizations that can plan projects and support veterans, and some may do both.

These search terms, **combined with your location**, will help you to identify the partners that will be most beneficial for you.

Note: The terms from the two columns can be used separately, to search for partners that serve a specific purpose, or they can be combined to help you identify a nonprofit that may be helpful in more than one area.

Examples: "Critical Home Repair Nonprofit Atlanta" "Veteran Service Dogs New York City" "Housing Nonprofit Homeless Veterans Chicago"
