

# DONATION COUPON INSTRUCTIONS

The \$25 Off Donation Coupons are one of several ways your store can support local nonprofits and invest in your community. This program is meant to assist local nonprofits with small community volunteer projects.

## WHO QUALIFIES

The Home Depot and The Home Depot Foundation support **registered IRS 501c3 designated nonprofit** organizations, public schools and city/county agencies in the United States and U.S. territories.

## QUARTERLY DELIVERY SCHEDULE TO STORES

- Once each quarter stores will receive twelve (12) -\$25 off Donation Coupons (value \$300) inside their Digital Communications Kit (DCK).
- 2. The coupons will be an attachment to an email sent to the ASDS.
- 3. The delivery schedule for the Digital Communications Kit (DCK) containing the donation coupons is:
  - Q1 March DCK
- Q3 September DCK
- Q2 June DCK
- Q4 December DCK

## **BEST PRACTICES**

- 1. If you don't already have a Store Team Depot Captain, then assign one or select an associate to manage this program.
- 2. How to manage your \$25 off donation coupons:
- Secure: Keep coupons in secure place (vault or locked file cabinet)
- Give: Donate coupons only to registered IRS 501c3 nonprofits, schools or city/county agencies. All nonprofits must provide a copy of their stamped IRS determination (tax-exempt) letter; Schools or city/ county agencies must provide you with a signed IRS W9 form.
- Record: Use the \$25 Off Coupon Log Sheet every time a coupon is issued to a nonprofit
- Redeem: Nonprofit must provide a copy of 501c3 letter or W9 and purchase \$25.01 or more for the coupon to be valid. Only one coupon can be redeemed per transaction.
- **File:** Staple together the coupon form, tax-exempt letter or W9 and any other documents provided to you by the nonprofit and keep in store file. Do not return to the Foundation.

## **SPECIAL NOTES**

- Donation coupons are not for internal (store or associate) use.
- All donations must follow The Home Depot Foundation guidelines as stated in the Best Practices section.
- Coupons can be used to support community projects like the Eagle Scouts. They must present to you a copy of the Boy Scouts 501c3 tax-exempt letter.
- Because the number of coupons available is limited do not guarantee or commit distribution to a nonprofit.
   Also, consider distributing only one (1) coupon per organization in order to help more groups.
